Prof. Jaimini Mehta is a practicing architect and an independent academic based in Baroda, India. He studied architecture at M.S. University of Baroda, graduating with Prof. M.B. Dave Gold Medal and at Uni. of Pennsylvania. He was an Adjunct Professor at Rensselaer Institute at Troy, N.Y. and at CEPT university in Ahmedabad, India. He was head of the Schools of Architecture at Baroda and Goa. At present he is Hon. Director of the Baroda based "Centre for the Study of Urbanism and Architecture". His published books, are "Rethinking Modernity - Towards Post Rational Architecture" (2011), "Embodied Vision – Interpreting the Architecture of Fatehpur Sikri" (2014) and "Critiquing the Modern in Architecture" (2017). "Non-Aesthetic Modernity in Architecture" and "Sense of History" are awaiting publication.

In 2018 he won the JK Architect of the Year award in the category of Literary Architecture.
