### SECOND YEAR - SATARA SETTLEMENT STUDY 2022-23

Satara is a city located around 100 Kms South of Pune in Maharashtra, near the tributary of River Krishna and River Venna. It was established in the 16<sup>th</sup> Century and was the seat of the Maratha Empire. The city is surrounded by seven forts, deriving its name SAT-TARA (seven forts). The city is located near features like forts, Ajinkyatara and Sajjangad, Kassi Plateau which is a world heritage site, Thosegar and Vajrai waterfalls.

It has Ghats along temple complex of Dakshin Kashi Shiv temple Sangam Mauli, Kshetra Mahuli temple lying across the river Krishna. The old and new City Palaces (*Juna and Nava Rajwada*) are located in the core of the city. With the old city core developed adjoining the palace, the city has grown in a concentric manner with newer contemporary developments on the outer perimeter.





### **THIRD YEAR - NASHIK SETTLEMENT STUDY 2022-23**

Nashik vibrant city in northern Maharashtra has developed, established and nurtured a culture and social significance along with intrinsic values of river Godavari and has gained its ethnic conglomeration of socio - culture. The temple architecture in this area became more elaborate with several small and large temples, shrines, thus making a mark of important pilgrimage center. This led to the construction of various Ghats, dharamshalas with typical streets patterns, and settlement along the periphery of the left bank of Godavari. The Ghats were adorned with various sacred pavilions and temples that signified their spiritual and religious qualities. Settlement Study played an integral part in experiential learning and has succeeded to impress the social, cultural and traditional architecture of Nashik.
